QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEACHING WITH STEPPINGSTONE

Candidates must have teaching experience, a strong background in their subject area, experience differentiating classroom instruction, and an interest in working with diverse populations. Independent school or Boston Public Schools teaching experience is preferred. Graduate students will be considered; undergraduate degree is required. Certification is not required.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interviews and hiring are conducted on an ongoing basis. Interested candidates are asked to submit via email a cover letter, a resume, and a list of three professional references to Human Resources, at jobs@tsf.org. Please note that candidates invited to interview will be asked to deliver a 5-10-minute demo lesson.
